2606/7 Current Housing Development in Goxhill		Cllr Carnell to raise issues and concerns. To agree any comments or actions henceforth. Concerns have been raised about the current development in the village. A resident who lives opposite said although the site was well organised, access is very poor as is transport management. He believes the boundary fence should be moved back to make access easier. At the moment lorries are backing on to The Bridles and on to people's drives. Trucks also arrive before the site is open and have to wait on the road.

		<i>There is plenty of room on the site and better access is needed. In addition, it is difficult to see vehicles coming out of the site.</i> <i>The traffic management plan is eight years old and Cllr Richard Hannigan has asked the planners to look at an alternative route to the site.</i> <i>Cllr Jones said that trucks should only arrive when the site is open. It is against the law to sit in the vehicle with the engine running. It was pointed out that the drivers need to get on with their job so will get to the site as soon as they can.</i> <i>It was suggested that the PC contacts Keigar about the problems. Cllr Favell said she would speak to ERNLLCA first for advice. Cllrs Gorbett, Ruddy and Elliott and neighbour Mr Barnes volunteered to form a working group.</i> <i>Cllr England said that if traffic was a problem now, a further 85 houses will add to the issues</i>
